

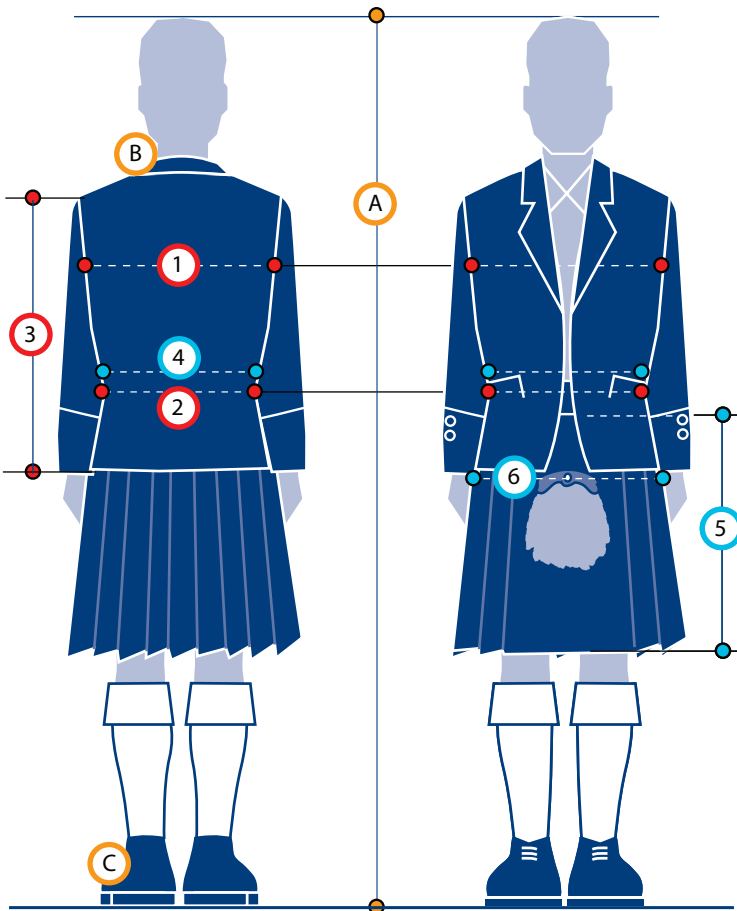

Self Measurement Form

KEY: ○ Jacket measurements ○ Kilt measurements ○ General measurements



Do not add anything to any dimensions

Around Chest/Bust

① Measure at fullest point under arms making sure the tape is well up at the back over the shoulderblades

Around Waist

② (natural waist)

Crown to Cuff (Sleeve length)

③ Ideally measured with a jacket on for accuracy with arms down by your side

Waist

④ Start your measuring over shirt only, 1.5 to 2 inches above the hip bone (about 1 inch below rib cage) snugly around your waist

Length

⑤ Start measuring 1.5 to 2 inches above your hip bone to the top or middle of your knee (whichever ever you prefer length wise)

Seat

⑥ Measure round your seat at the heaviest part, add 4 fingers inside the tape to avoid getting this measurement too tight as the seat should be an easy measurement. (no wallets etc. in pockets)

Height

A This measurement is important since it is a second check for us.
